**Request for Sewer – East Pembroke and Rose Lane**

Chairman Charles Trombetta called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. In attendance were committee members James Johnson and Paul Rotello and City Engineer, Farid Khouri and the petitioner, Ian Chang.

Councilman Johnson stated that the charge of the committee was to consider the request for sanitary sewer at East Pembroke Road and Rose Lane. A positive recommendation was received from the Planning Commission.

Mr. Khouri explained that there is an existing manhole on Calmly Lane. There is also an assessment project to extend the sewer from East Pembroke Road to Cornell Road. He stated that Mr. Chang could be included in the assessment project. Mr. Chang has the option to connect as part of the assessment project or connect individually at his own expense from the manhole on Calmly Lane. Mr. Khouri recommended that #3 Rose Lane connect as part of the assessment project.

Councilman Rotello moved to approve the petition based on the standard eight steps if Mr. Chang chooses to connect from Cally Lane or as part of the Cornell Assessment Project. Second by Mr. Johnson. Motion passed unanimously.

Councilman Johnson moved to adjourn at 6:43 p.m. Motion seconded by Mr. Johnson. Motion passed unanimously.
