



The Youth Center is in its busiest season, with basketball, wrestling, cheerleading and other events as well as rentals keeping the doors open 16/7.

The Harlem Rockets basketball game was held on the 9<sup>th</sup> to a capacity crowd of small children and adults who came to see comedy basketball at it's finest. The Rockets played against a team of Danbury Police Officers and it was a fun night for all that attended.

The Hospital employee parking is ongoing without incident or conflict with our other events.

Danbury Police Training is being held at the center and it is a very suitable location for many of our training needs. It is gratifying to have the officers at the center becoming familiar with their facility.

The Danbury Hospital Wellness on Wheels van is here once a week administering flu shots to members of the community.

The travel basketball season is in full swing with 10 teams from PAL participating in the Westchester County Basketball League.

The in house girls program is set to kick off with this Saturday being the final day of registration before Christmas. The league will begin in January.

PAL will be conducting its annual raffle a little later in the season this year. For the first time in at least 20 years, PAL will not be raffling off a vehicle. This year the raffle prize will be a gift pack of 10 rounds of golf for a foursome at area golf courses. Tickets will be \$20 and the raffle will run through May of 2007, just in time for the beginning of the golf season.
