Old Business

1. Naming a Poet Laureate for the City sent for the Mayor to review

The Mayor's office has no objection. The Commission will set up a seven-member, Danbury Poet Laureate Selection Committee which will include members of the Danbury Cultural Commission, Danbury Library staff, poetry advocates, representatives from the school and senior communities, and others. The Danbury Cultural Commission Coordinator will help coordinate the application process.

Applications will be accepted from July 15, 2023 through September 15, 2023

MOTION: by EMoore to proceed with naming a poet laureate per recommendations set up in February. Seconded by GSmith.

DISCUSSION: A number of Commissioners said they would be interested in serving. It was suggested that EMoor's father might be interested.
