1. **Storytelling Telebration**, Bertha MacCarry, requested \$600 for this year's program which will feature nationally known storyteller/performer Jonathan Kruk. The program will take place on Nov. 18 at the Danbury Library: 12:30 to 1:30 for childrens programs and 1:30 to 2:30 for families and adults. This is Danbury's seventh year of this popular free international storytelling project.

2. **The Indian Assoc. of Western Ct., Inc.**, Katom Bjavsar requested \$1,250 for their Festival of Lights NAVRATRI. This year the event will take place at the Henry Abbott Tech School in Danbury on Oct. 20 and Oct. 27 from 7:30 pm to midnight. The program will feature live music, Indian food, crafts, etc.

3. **Reports on DCC sponsored events**: It was reported that the series of concerts, Art exhibits and programs were very good this year. The Danbury Concert Series performance by a talented pianist was excellent it was stated.

Action Taken: .H. Center moved we grant \$500. to the *Indian Assoc.*, H. Center seconded the motion which was passed. M. Schwartz moved we grant \$600 to *the Storytelling Telebration*. Motion was seconded by H. Center and passed.


New Business: G. Wencek reported on some plans he has for expanding our Email and possibly upgrading our internet program.
