There was a special meeting of the Fire Pension Board on Thursday, March 7, 2013 at 08:45 am in Jim Johnson's office at City Hall.

On the agenda:

- 1. Pension request of Justin Bierbower**
- 2. A Domestic Relations Order concerning Dean Singer.**
- 3. Pension request of Steve Omasta.**

The meeting was called to order by Jim Johnson at 08:45m am. In attendance were Mr. Johnson, Mr. St. Hilaire, Mr. Omasta, Mr. Curran, Mr. Pollard, and attorney Diane Rosemark.

First order of business was to accept the DRO concerning Dean Singer. A motion was made to accept the signed DRO by Mr. St Hilaire and seconded by Mr. Curran. Motion passed by all.

Because medical records would be discussed on the next two items on the agenda, a motion to move to Executive session was made by Mr. Curran and seconded by Mr. Pollard. Motion passed by all. Executive session was started.

A motion was made to return to regular session was made by Mr. St Hilaire and seconded by Mr. Curran. Motion was passed, regular session was resumed.

The next order of business was the pension request of Justin Bierbower. Mr. Bierbower requested a pension under the Post 67 Pension Plan, Sec. 14-32, (Retirement for a disability incurred in the line of duty). The board had received reports from two Doctors the city had sent Mr. Bierbower to and both doctors agreed that the injury was sustained in the line of duty and that Mr. Bierbower could no longer perform the duties of a firefighter.

Mr. Bierbower will receive 66 2/3 (sixty-six and two thirds) of his pay and his retirement will be effective Sunday March 10, 2013.

A motion to retire Mr. Bierbower was made by Mr. St Hilaire, seconded by Mr. Curran and passed by all.

The next order of business was the pension request of Lt. Steven Omasta. Mr. Omasta requested a pension under Sec. 14-32 of the Post 67 Pension Plan, (Retirement for a disability incurred in the line of duty). Since there was found a need for clarification from one of the examining physicians, a motion was made by Mr. Curran to continue his request to a future meeting until clarification from the physician in question was received. Motion was seconded by Mr. St Hilaire. The motion was passed by all.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Curran and seconded by Mr. Pollard. Motion was passed by all, adjournment was made.
