There was a special meeting of the Danbury Fire Pension Board held on July,29, 2014 in the Office of the Fire Marshal.

The meeting was called to order at 5:00pm on July 29, 2014. In attendance was Mayor Boughton, Chief Curran, Chief Slagle, Lieutenant Pollard, and by conference call, Chief Omasta.

On the agenda:

1). The pension request of Firefighter Lou DeMici. Mr. DeMici requested pension under Sec. 14-31 (Optional Retirement) with 35 years of service. He requested an August 4, 2014 retirement date.

Chief Curran made a motion to approve the pension for Firefighter Lou DeMici. The motion was seconded by Lieutenant Pollard. Under discussion, Mr. DeMici was thanked for his 35 years of service to the City of Danbury and to his service to Local 801. He was wished well on his retirement. The motion was passed by all. The pension for Mr. DeMici will be sixty (68) percent of top step Firefighters pay and effective on August 4, 2014.

2). The pension request of Lieutenant Fred Pollard. Mr. Pollard requested a pension under Sec. 14-30 (Mandatory Retirement for age). Mr. Pollard will be retired on September 6, 2014 as that is the day after his 65<sup>th</sup> birthday. Also under Sec 14-29(b) since his "highest salary or compensation received" was first step Captain.

Chief Slagle made a motion to grant Lieutenant Pollard, seconded by Chief Curran, Under discussion, Lieutenant Pollard was thanked for his service and dedication to the City of Danbury by all attendees. The motion was passed by all with Lieutenant Pollard abstaining. Mr. Pollard will receive a pension for fifty (50) percent of first step Captains pay and be effective on September 6, 2014.

Chief Curran made a motion for adjournment, seconded by Lieutenant Pollard. No discussion, adjournment was made at 5:07pm.
