### Special Meeting

There was a special meeting of the Firemen's Pension Board at City Hall on May 14, 2015.

On the agenda,

- 1) Pension request from DFM William Weber.
- 2) Pension request from DEM Mark Perry.
- 3) Pension request from DFM Marilyn Gillotti.

Mr. Slagle convened the meeting at 4:10 pm.

In attendance were board members, Mayor Boughton, Phil Curran, Paul Omasta & Charly Slagle.

Mr. Slagle stated DFM Weber's IME reports were back.

Mr. Slagle made a motion to accept the reports, seconded by Mr. Omasta. No discussion and the motion passed. Reports were disrupted to members prior to the meeting.

Mr. Boughton made a motion, to grant DFM William a pension under sec. 14-33 disability not connected with duties, based on the IME reports. At a rate of 65% of top step Deputy Fire Marshal annual pay. Mr. Curran seconded the motion. No discussion. Motion was passed unanimously. Mr. Slagle thanked DFM Webber for his 30 years of service in the Fire Department and wish Bill and his family the best in the future. The effective date will be May 17, 2015.

Mr. Slagle stated he had received a letter from DFM Perry requesting a pension under section 14-31(a), Optional retirement, for 30 years of service. Mr. Slagle made a motion to accept the letter. Seconded by Mr. Omasta. No discussion and the motion passed.

Mr. Boughton made a motion to grant DFM Perry a pension under sec. 14-31(a) Optional retirement at a rate of 60% of top step Deputy Fire Marshal annual pay. Mr. Curran second the motion. No discussion. Motion passed unanimously. The effective date will be May 31, 2015. Mr. Curran thanked DFM Perry for his 30 years of service in the Fire Department and wishes Mark and his family the best in the future.

Mr. Slagle stated he was in receipt of a letter from FM Marilyn Gillotti requesting a pension under section 14-31(a), Optional retirement, for 27 years of service. Mr. Slagle made a motion to accept the letter. Second by Mr. Omasta. No discussion and the motion passed. Mr. Curran made a motion to grant FM Gillotti a pension under sec. 14-31(a) Optional retirement at a rate of 54% of first step Fire Marshal annual pay. Mr.
