Re: Danbury Public Library Fire - Emergency Measures

Dear Mayor and Council Members:

As a result of the disastrous fire at the Danbury Public Library last night, immediate action is required to minimize disruption to library patrons. At this time, it is anticipated that Common Council approval will be necessary in order to allow administration staff to begin the process in the most expeditious way possible. Of critical concern are the rehabilitation of the library itself as well as securing temporary space elsewhere.

With that in mind, we ask that you consider allowing the purchasing department to waive the customary bid process, where necessary. This would permit us to arrange, through our insurance carrier, for the hiring of rehabilitation and construction experts. In addition, it would allow us to purchase equipment, furniture and books to replace those destroyed in the fire, and do it within the 90 to 120 day timeframe we have set for the restoration of services at the library.

Further, we seek your approval of a short term, month to month, lease of space generously offered to the City by the Union Savings Bank at the Galleria on Main Street. We are in the process of discussing the terms of this lease with officials of the Union Savings Bank and hope to have it ready for you tomorrow night.

Any additional action on this matter that needs your attention will be presented to you at that time.
