The Committee of the Whole met on July 22, 1996 at 7:30 p.m. in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall.

Mr. Setaro explained that this is a program by which non-profit organizations approved by the City and State may receive donations from corporations and the corporations will receive a tax credit for a percentage of their donation from the State Department of Revenue Services.
