Re: Waiver of Bids

On October 25, 1982, this department received a requisition for three overhead doors for a storage building being constructed to house the Tana Compactor at the City Landfill. The building must be at least moderately warm to protect the equipment from damage, and to insure cold weather starting. These doors are necessary to allow us to heat the building.

Specifications for the doors were received from the department on November 2, 1982. We estimate the price at between \$3,000. and \$4,000. The normal bid procedure would delay the installation of the doors, and would present an undue hardship on the Landfill operations. It would be impossible to prepare and award a bid in less than four weeks.

I request a waiver of the bid procedure, and permission to obtain three quotations. We would purchase from the lowest bidder.

Thank you for your consideration of this matter.
