



After having carefully figured the Commission's needs to get through fiscal year '79-80, the Commission was given supplemental monies through action by the Common Council. However, the commission was caught in a bind when it was forced to readvertise the numerous public hearings it had scheduled for May 7th because the alternates could not be used, and the public hearings had to be cancelled. These hearings were subsequently held June 4th.

The Commission has advertised nine public hearings for July 2, 1980, the approximate cost for which will be \$134.00. The purchase orders are being held in the Planning Office until funds are available and the orders can be accepted by the Purchasing Department.
