Re: Special Common Council Meeting held July 24, 1989.

NOTICE OF THE SPECIAL MEETING - To be held on the 24th day of July, 1989 in the Common Council Chambers in City Hall for the purpose of acting upon the following:

1. REPORT & RESOLUTION - Permit Fees.

Mr. Moran made a motion to accept the call. Seconded by Mr. Gallo. Motion carried unanimously.

1. REPORT & RESOLUTION - Permit Fees.

Mr. Nimmons gave a verbal report recommending approval of the following amended Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Danbury Code of Ordinances authorizes the establishment of Passenger and Non-Passenger Vehicle Permit and User Fees for the use of the Danbury Sanitary Landfill site; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council did adopt said fees on May 18, 1989; and

WHEREAS, the following modification to said fees is deemed to be in the best interests of the City of Danbury;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Permit Fees for Commercial Non-Passenger Vehicle Permits which may be obtained for vehicles bearing Commercial or Temporary Commercial registration plates issued by the Connecticut Department of Motor Vehicles shall be fixed as follows:

(a) For pickup trucks with a rated capacity of three-quarters of a ton or less, said permit fees shall be TWENTY (\$20.00) DOLLARS per year for each vehicle.

(b) For trucks with a rated capacity of more than three-quarters of a ton, whose owners are not primarily engaged in the business of hauling wastes, said permit fees shall be ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE (\$125.00) DOLLARS per year for the first vehicle and ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS per year for each additional vehicle.

(c) For trucks with a rated capacity of more than three-quarters of a ton, whose owners are primarily engaged in the business of hauling wastes, said permit fees shall be TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY (\$250.00) DOLLARS per year for the first vehicle and ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS per year for each additional vehicle.

(d) The resolution adopted by the Common Council on May 18, 1989 regarding said fees shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect.


(e) Refunds of any payments made by landfill users pursuant to the resolution of May 18, 1989 in excess of those payments approved herein are hereby authorized.

Mr. Moran made a motion to accept the verbal report and adopt the Resolution. Seconded by Mrs. Danise. Motion carried unanimously.
