The committee recommends to the Common Council that the revised Peddlers Ordinance be deferred to public hearing and that a committee be appointed to draft a Vendors Ordinance.


ORDINANCE - Amendment to Section 11-4 of the Code of Ordinances re: Peddlers.

Councilmen DaSilva and Torian requested that the Ordinance be deferred for Public Hearing.


Council President McManus so ordered, and stated that a committee is to be appointed by the Mayor to draft the Vendors Ordinance.
