SUBJECT: Minutes of the Special Meeting of the Common Council held on November 17, 1983.

The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 O'Clock P.M. in the absence of the Mayor, by Common Council President Constance McManus who led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

01 - REPORT & ORDINANCE - Peddlers.

Council President C. McManus submitted a report stating that the Common Council held a public hearing on Thursday, November 10, 1983 at 8:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers at City Hall, regarding the Peddler Ordinance.

The committee of the whole met on November 16, 1983 at 8:00 P.M. and recommended to amend the Ordinance in the following manner:

- (C) - 4 should be amended to read "honorably discharged veterans".
- (L) - should be amended to read "products liability coverage in the amount of \$500,000" each occurrence.

The Council as a committee of the whole voted unanimously to recommend the amended Ordinance be approved.

A motion was made by Councilman Evans and seconded by Councilman Torian to accept the Report.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Torcaso and seconded by Councilman Evans to amend the Ordinance by deleting the phrase "in time of war". Motion carried.

ORDINANCE - Amendment to Section 11-4 Re: Peddlers.

The Ordinance, as amended, was adopted unanimously by a roll call vote of 15 Ayes - 6 members absent.

There being no public speakers and no further business to come before the Common Council, a motion was made by Councilman Evans and seconded by Councilwoman Torcaso for the meeting to be adjourned at 7:35 O'Clock P.M. Motion carried.
