**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** Mark D. Boughton, Mayor of the City of Danbury, is hereby authorized to approve and submit the City's Annual Action Plan for Program Year 36 and make application on behalf of the City of Danbury to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for grant funds for the Community Development Program Year commencing August 1, 2010 through July 31, 2011 for the Thirty-Sixth Year Funding in accordance with all pertinent laws and regulations and the Statement of Community Development Objectives and Projected Use of Funds proposed by the Mayor's Community Development Program Policy Committee.
