

**AD HOC COMMITTEE
7 NEW STREET EASEMENT/RIGHTS TO DRAIN**

Chairman Robert Arconti called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM on April 6, 2010. In attendance were Committee Member Phil Colla, Corporation Counsel Les Pinter, Permit Co-Ordinator Sean Hearty, City Engineer Farid Khory and ex-officio Colleen Stanley. Committee Member Duane Perkins was absent.

Mr. Arconti said the charge of the committee was to consider 7 New St. Rights to Drain. Mr. Khory the City Engineer said the building is located across from City Hall and was rebuilt following a fire. The owner requested an easement in order to tie a footing drain into the street with the line that would run under the sidewalk and in front of a neighboring property. The new proposal would now put a new catch basin out in front of the building, then tie into an existing catch basin further down, all on the street. The City will need a bill of sale and will own the catch basin and there will no longer be a need for an easement provided the contractor verifies with the permit center for the necessary permits to file and secure the appropriate bond for this work.

Mrs. Stanley asked if the petitioner agrees with the proposal. Mr. Khory said yes.

Mr. Colla moved to take no action on the request for easement, based upon the Permit Center requirements, none will be required, and the drainage remedy will be handled administratively. The motion was seconded by Mr. Arconti. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Colla moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:15PM. Seconded by Mr. Arconti. The motion passed unanimously.
