Attached for your review is a resolution that will allow the City of Danbury to apply for and accept funding from the Northwest Regional Workforce Investment Board(NRWIB) for a Youth Employment program offered through the State of Connecticut Department of Social Services.

This funding will allow the City of Danbury to employ up to 23 student participants from July 1, 2010-September 30, 2010 and will not exceed \$32,000. The NRWIB had previously offered a separate funding opportunity for a youth employment program through the Department of Labor, which was adopted on the June 2010 agenda. These two programs will be coordinated in conjunction with each other through the Mayor's Office. There is no City match required.

The City Council is respectfully requested to consider this resolution at its next meeting. Please contact me should you require any additional information.

RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANBURY

WHEREAS, the Northwest Regional Workforce Investment Board has notified the City of Danbury of a funding opportunity through the State of Connecticut Department of Social Services; and

WHEREAS, this funding will enable the City of Danbury to employ up to 23 student participants for employment during the summer of 2010 through the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families(TANF) program; and

WHEREAS, this program will engage the participants in work experience including learning daily operations of the assigned workplace, interaction with the public, effective communication and timely attendance at work; and

WHEREAS, this funding, not exceed \$32,000, is available from July 1, 2010 through September 30, 2010 and requires no City match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Mark D. Boughton, Mayor of the City of Danbury, is hereby authorized to apply for and accept said funding to sign any contracts, memorandums of agreement or documents in connection therewith to effectuate the purposes of said grant.


Dear Members of the City Council:
