The Peter & Carmen Lucia Buck Foundation Grant

Founded in 1999, the Buck foundation focuses on 7 sectors, one of which directly correlates with the Department of Elderly Services: funding "Danbury Area Projects" that include the elderly. The foundation has approached this department and through discussion has offered to fund \$25,000 for a part-time coordinator for the Elmwood Hall Senior center. The foundation believes that this will have a far reaching benefit to seniors on both a micro and macro level. On a micro level, programs of all types can be expanded to benefit elderly clients directly. On a macro level, the director of elderly services' schedule will soften as to allow for a key role in the creation and execution of the foundation's long-term plan of "Aging in Place" for the areas' elderly population.
