The City of Danbury's Health and Human Services received funding from the Department of Social Services (DSS) grant for Contract Term as Amended: October 1, 2010 – September 30, 2012. The final total of this two year grant was set at \$230,205.

The amended amount under Contract No: 034-ESS-23 / 10DSS3701GT is now \$200,623. The monies returned to DSS (approximately \$29,582.00) were due to the State denying several requests for improvements to the Emergency Shelter such as: the purchase of computers, printers, job employment computer program/training, security system, Red Cross/CPR training of staff, and upgrade to the front walkway and entrance of the Emergency Shelter.

Regardless of the State not approving requested improvements, the Emergency Shelter and Day Center will continue to provide supportive services and case management expertise for our homeless population. The Emergency Shelter strives to improve and strength the quality of life for those who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.

The funding provided by DSS will continue to assist and facilitate the efficient and effective operations at the Emergency Shelter with the City Council's approval of this amendment.
