# ORDINANCE

CITY OF DANBURY, STATE OF CONNECTICUT

**Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Danbury:**

That Sec. 2-176 of the Code of Ordinances of Danbury, Connecticut, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 2-176. Schedule of termination of government entities.**

**(a) The following governmental entities are terminated, effective June 30, 2014, unless reestablished in accordance with section 2-184:**

- (1) The City of Danbury Cultural Commission.
- (2) The Commission on Aging.
- (3) The Parking Authority of the City of Danbury.
- (4) The Danbury Housing Partnership.
- (5) The Lake Kenosia Commission.

**(b) The following governmental entities are terminated, effective June 30, 2015, unless reestablished in accordance with section 2-184:**

- (1) The Flood and Erosion Control Board of the City of Danbury.
- (2) The Tarrywile Park Authority.
- (3) The Youth Commission.

**(c) The following governmental entities are terminated, effective June 30, 2016, unless reestablished in accordance with section 2-184:**

- (1) The Danbury Parks and Recreation Commission.
- (2) The Aviation Commission.

**(d) The following governmental entities are terminated, effective June 30, 2017, unless reestablished in accordance with section 2-184:**

- (1) The Commission for Persons with Disabilities.
- (2) The Danbury Aquifer Protection Agency.
- (3) The Fair Rent Commission.
- (4) The Board of Ethics.
- (5) The Charles Ives Authority for the Performing Arts.

**(e) The following governmental entities are terminated, effective June 30, 2018, unless reestablished in accordance with section 2-184:**

- (1) The Stanley Lasker Richter Memorial Park Authority.
- (2) The Conservation Commission.
- (3) The Environmental Impact Commission.
- (4) The Danbury Museum and Historical Society Authority.
- (5) The Danbury Main Street Partnership.
