Attached for your review is a resolution that will allow the City of Danbury Health and Human Services Department to apply for and accept funding from the State of Connecticut Department of Public Health for the School Based Health Center programs at Danbury High School, Broadview Middle School and Rogers Park Middle School. This funding will be subcontracted to the Connecticut Institute for Communities, Inc. [a Connecticut non-profit, IRS recognized 501(c) (3) organization] which currently operates a federally qualified health center at Henry Abbott Technical High School.

The three-year State contract runs from 7/1/13-6/30/16 for a maximum amount of \$1,490,967. The allocation will be \$496,967 for each of Years 1, 2, and 3.
