
Dear Mayor and City Council Members:

Dear Councilman Scozzafava,

I am writing at your suggestion to request the use of the fenced area known as "Camp Thunderbird". This space will be used as an overflow parking lot when there are large events at the Lodge, such as the upcoming Festival in August, and parking is limited due to Soccer matches and/or practices being held at the same time. We feel that we will be able to park from 20 to 30 vehicles in this area.

We will clear the property and maintain the parking area. In addition, we will insure that the buildings are secured from being used.
