The Connecticut Department of Public Health provides the City funds for the Preventive Health Block Grant and recently sent the City of Danbury a new 3-year budget application package in the amount of \$67,701.

The City of Danbury relies on the grant from the State of Connecticut to fund the Skin Cancer Prevention Grant Funding Period One (10/01/2015 – 09/30/2016). The grant should be used entirely during the final year of the 3 Year SBHC Operations contract with CIFIC at Broadview, Rogers Park and the Danbury High School.

The Grant Funding Periods 2 and 3 of the PHBG contract (10/01/2016 through 09/30/2018) are to be used for the extension of the 5-2-1-0 Let's Go program lead by the United Way of Western CT (see attached).
