Attached for your review is a resolution that will allow the City of Danbury Fire Department to accept funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency. This funding will be used by the Fire Marshal's office to purchase a Combination Sprinkler/Fire Safety House for use in their fire prevention activities. Requested funding from FEMA is \$68,000 with the City contributing an additional \$17,000. The City funding is available in the 07/08 Fire Department contributions and grants budget(2010.5855).

The Common Council is respectfully requested to consider this resolution at its next meeting.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has allowed the Danbury Fire Department to apply for funding through a Fire Prevention grant; and

WHEREAS, this funding request is to be used for a Combination Sprinkler/Fire Safety House for use by the Danbury Fire Marshal's office in their Fire Prevention activities; and

WHEREAS the FEMA portion is 80% of the cost which totals \$68,000 and the 20% City match totals \$17,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Mark D. Boughton, Mayor of the City of Danbury, or Fire Chief Geoffrey Herald, as his designee, be and hereby are authorized to apply for and accept said grant and to execute such additional documents as may be required to effectuate the purposes thereof.



Same as our Combination Sprinkler Safety House, but we have added a multi media cabinet. Designed on a 39 foot frame, the front of the coach is designed for live burn demonstrations. The large lexan windows allow the participants to view this dramatic demonstration from the outside. The walls of the activation room are wrapped from the fire to the sprinkler head. The trough style drain system and sloped floor allow for easy water drainage. The rest of the coach is designed with a full size kitchen, control room and a bedroom. Sprinkler system includes; a 1/2 hp pump, PEX & copper piping, water tank and 135 degree sprinkler head.
