ORDINANCE
CITY OF DANBURY, STATE OF CONNECTICUT
COMMON COUNCIL

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Danbury:

8-17. Failure to comply with orders of the Fire Marshal.

Any person who fails or refuses to comply with an order of abatement issued by the Danbury Fire Marshal, or his authorized designees, pursuant to the authority granted by the Connecticut General Statutes, shall be subject to a fine of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) for each violation. The Danbury Fire Marshal, or his authorized designees in addition to such other remedies as may be provided by the Connecticut General Statutes, is hereby authorized to enforce the provisions of this section through the issuance of citations in accordance with the citation procedure set forth in sections 12-34 and 12-35 of the code of ordinances of the City of Danbury.
