
I am in the process of getting a building permit for a new single family home on this lot. As part of the permit application process the Engineering Department has performed their review of my plan and has found it satisfactory.

The plan involves installing approximately 49 feet of 24in. drainage pipe and attaching it to an existing catch basin in Aspen Way, and then constructing at the end of the new pipe a vegetated drainage channel of approximately 120 feet in length.

The Engineering Department has requested (see attached July 13, 2004 letter from Patricia A. Ellsworth, P.E. the Assistant City Engineer) that I get approval from the Common Council for the City to accept ownership of the pipe, to accept the drainage easement areas, and to accept rights to drain in favor of the City.


