
**Re: Proposed Sanitary Sewer Extension

Dear Council Members,

My client, the owner of 10 Great Pasture Road, wishes to have the benefit of municipal sanitary sewer service for his property. The subject property is situated on the Danbury-Bethel corporate boundary line. Danbury's municipal sanitary sewer currently terminates in Great Pasture Road, approximately 1,000 feet northwest of the subject site. However, due to existing topographic conditions it is not possible to extend the existing gravity sewer main to the site. The Town of Bethel's existing municipal sanitary sewer main terminates in Wooster Street, approximately 250 feet southeast of the site. The Bethel sewer is down gradient from the subject property, thus a gravity sewer extension is possible and preferable. We have had preliminary discussions with a representative of the Town of Bethel regarding extension of sanitary sewer services to this site. It was recommended in these discussions that the property owner obtain permission from the City of Danbury prior to applying to the Town of Bethel Sewer Commission.

On behalf of our client, we respectfully request that the City of Danbury Common Council consider this request for extension of services.
