The runway intersection was rehabilitated in October, 1986. This October it will be 23 years old. The runway intersection needs to be reconstructed as it is not cost effective for the city to put any additional monies into crack filling and patch work of the intersection.

For your consideration, attached is a resolution and a request from the Airport for the city's share of \$6,325.00 so that we may receive \$499,675.00 of federal and state monies. This project will also include drainage work on Taxiway Bravo. The total cost of the project is \$506,000.

RESOLUTION

RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Danbury:



WHEREAS, the City of Danbury wishes to apply to the Federal Aviation Administration for grant funding, which if approved, will enable the City to reconstruct Runway intersection and drainage repairs on Taxiway B, as described and attached in Exhibit A, in connection with the Airport Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Federal Aviation Administration grant application process, 95% of the grant funds will be committed by the Federal Aviation Administration, 3.75% of the grant funds will be committed by the State of Connecticut and the City will be responsible to fund 1.25% of the total grant amount.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council hereby authorizes Mayor Mark D. Boughton and Paul D. Estefan, Airport Administrator, to apply to the Federal Aviation Administration to obtain grant funding and to ratify the submission and receipt of said funding for the improvements referenced above; to appropriate the 1.25% of the total grant amount, if the grant is approved; to execute any necessary documents; and to take any additional actions necessary to effectuate the purposes hereof.
