Attached for your review is a resolution that will allow the City of Danbury Fire Department to apply for and accept funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). This request for funding will be used to purchase a 'Combination Sprinkler/Fire Safety House with Multi Media Cabinet' for use in fire prevention activities.

If awarded, funding from FEMA will be 80% of the total cost, or \$69,060, and the City match will be 20% of the total cost, or \$17,266, of which the funds will come from account 2010.5714(Public Safety Equipment).

The Common Council is respectfully requested to consider this resolution at its next meeting.

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Emergency Management Agency(FEMA) has allowed the Danbury Fire Department to apply for funding through a Fire Prevention grant; and

**WHEREAS**, this funding request is to be used for a Combination Sprinkler/Fire Safety House with Multi Media Cabinet for use by the Danbury Fire Department for Fire Prevention activities; and

**WHEREAS** the FEMA portion of 80% of the cost totals \$69,060 and the 20% City Match totals \$17,266.
