Dear Honorable Mayor and Members of the Common Council:

The runway intersection was rehabilitated in October, 1986. This October is will be 23 years old. The runway intersection needs to be reconstructed as it is not cost effective for the city to put any additional monies into crack filling and patch work of the intersection.

For your consideration, attached is a resolution and a request from the Airport for the city's share of \$6,583.00, to be funded from account number 9200-5511, so that we may receive \$500,318.00 of Federal monies and \$19,749 of State monies. This project will also include drainage work on Taxiway Bravo. The total cost of the project is \$526,650.00.

RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Danbury:

WHEREAS, the City of Danbury has applied to and received from the Federal Aviation Administration full project grant funding, which will enable the City to reconstruct Runway intersection and drainage repairs on Taxiway B, as described and attached in Exhibit A, in connection with the Airport Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Federal Aviation Administration grant application process, 95% of the grant funds will be committed by the Federal Aviation Administration, 3.75% of the grant funds will be committed by the State of Connecticut and the City will be responsible to fund 1.25% of the total grant amount funded through account 9200-5511.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council hereby authorizes Mayor Mark D. Boughton and Paul D. Estefan, Airport Administrator, to apply to the Federal Aviation Administration to obtain grant funding in the full amount, and as may be amended by the FAA, and to ratify the submission and receipt of said funding for the improvements referenced above; to appropriate the 1.25% of the total grant amount, if the grant is approved; to execute any necessary documents; and to take any additional actions necessary to effectuate the purposes hereof.
