Re: Clean City Danbury Day/Donation of Disposable Services

Dear Mayor Boughton and Members of the Common Council:

As you are aware, on April 9, 2005 the City of Danbury held its second annual Clean City Danbury Day. Many of you assisted at the various locations around the City and helped coordinate the activities on that day. Prior to that time, I had arranged for a donation to the City of the disposal fees for the garbage and rubbish collected, as well as of the roll-off containers and the drivers needed to transport these materials.

The total amount of waste material that was collected on that day equaled 103.68 tons. Waste tonnage is normally disposed of at 305 White Street at a cost of \$87.00 a ton. The total value of the tonnage disposed of is \$9,020.16. Additionally, during the day, drivers working for AWD pulled roll-off containers from our remote sites and disposed of that material at 305 White Street. The total amount of vehicle trips equaled twenty-four. Those trips are normally billed to us at a rate of \$150.00 per roll-off container. The total value of that portion of the work is \$3,600.00. On behalf of the Danbury Trashers, the championship ice hockey team, Mr. A.J. Gallante has agreed to donate the cost of these services to the City of Danbury as his way, and the team's way, of supporting Clean City Danbury.

Based on the above, I respectfully request that you accept this donation, which has an equivalent value of \$12,620.16.
