
Dear Common Council Members:

The City of Danbury is making great progress in planning and design of the new Danbury Head Start facility at the former Immanuel Lutheran School site. We have completed acquisition of the property and anticipate voter support of funding to complete the project. As you know, this unique project, unlike any other Head Start facility in Connecticut, will provide precious classroom space in our elementary schools. The redeployment of these classrooms effectively provides our community with another school at less than half the cost of new construction.

We originally scheduled a referendum for September 13, 2005 to meet deadlines imposed by the Connecticut General Assembly. After further consideration, I have scheduled a public information session to fully inform Danbury's voters about this project on Thursday, September 15, 2005 at 7:00 PM in the Common Council Chambers. The attached documents request rescheduling our referendum to Tuesday, September 27, 2005.



RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Danbury:

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL CITY MEETING

RESOLVED: That the ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Appropriating \$5,600,000 For Renovations And Improvements To The Old Immanuel Lutheran School And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$5,600,000 Bonds Of The City To Meet Said Appropriation And Pending The Issuance Thereof The Making Of Temporary Borrowings For Such Purpose" be submitted for approval or disapproval at a Special City Meeting to be called by the Mayor pursuant to Section 7-10(a) of the Revised City Charter and held September 27, 2005, between the hours of 6:00 o'clock A.M. and 8:00 o'clock P.M. (E.S.T.), that the Warning of said meeting state the questions to be voted on as follows:
