RE: Dells Auto Wrecking - Request for Appointment of Ad Hoc Committee


Dear President Nolan and Members of the Common Council:

I am writing to request the appointment of a Common Council Committee to determine the options available to the city to ensure compliance with current land use laws by Dells Auto Wrecking and facilitate the construction of a new fence between Dells and Plumtrees Road. I understand that such a project was previously explored by the Ginsberg Development Corporation, which offered thousands of dollars towards the construction of a new fence and plantings along the road. However, I was told that the offer was rejected by Dells based in part on the concern that if a new fence was built it would have to be built further from the road to comply with current land use and setback requirements.

Since that time the physical appeared of Dells has not improved and I have received an increasing number of inquiries from constituents, businesses asking for something to be done. Most recently the Board of Trustees of the Fourth Ward Community Fund voted to provide financial support to assist with efforts to improve the aesthetics of the Plumtrees Road corridor, including the area in front of Dells.
