Subject: **Lease Renewal Request – Bear Mountain Cottage**

The Conservation Commission is requesting that Lt. Shaun McColgan of the Danbury Police Department be granted renewal of his lease at the Bear Mountain Park cottage for three years (2006-2008), January through December, as we are involved in the overall operation of the park.

In 2004, Commission members voted unanimously to recommend that a police officer be given first preference for the rent, as they have authority and the knowledge that an officer is resident on the property acts as a deterrent.

Since taking up residence at Bear Mountain, Lt. McColgan has regularly attended the Commission's monthly meetings and has also taken an active role in the monitoring and upkeep of the premises. Thus, we request that his lease be renewed for three years.
