WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG) under the Fiscal Year 2006 Local Solicitation (Edward Byrne Memorial) has advised the City of Danbury of its eligibility to apply to JAG for a direct award of \$16,657.00 under this program with no local cash match required; and

WHEREAS, the funding under this new program will be used by the Danbury Police Department to purchase various items of equipment to enhance effective law enforcement within the City of Danbury; and

WHEREAS, the grant period will run for four (4) years from the date of the initial payment received.


