Dear Mayor Boughton and Members of the Common Council:

Attached you will find the monthly report for the month of July 2006 for the Engineering Department of the City of Danbury. Before this month's Common Council meeting, I will email you the current City Projects list with a short status report on each of the projects. I will also attach the latest assessment projects list.

Assessment projects: in the next three weeks, we will pave the streets in the Jackson Drive/Woodbury Drive area sanitary sewer assessment project. The Nancy Drive/Carolyn Avenue area sanitary sewer assessment project continues to move forward. We installed the water line and paved Shore Road as part of the Hawthorne Terrace drinking water assessment project, and we are hopeful that Phase II will begin shortly.

Regarding Engine 26, the City signed contracts and construction has begun, with expected completion in June 2007.

With respect to the Library Place Parking Garage, groundbreaking on the project took place on August 28, 2006, and construction has started.

As far as the Kaplanis Memorial Field project, bids were opened on August 8, 2006, and the City awarded the three phases to H.I. Stone & Son. Construction will begin in September 2006 and the field is expected to be completed in November 2006.

The Magnet School has been completed and the ribbon-cutting ceremony took place on August 22, 2006. The Rogers Park Middle School renovations are underway. The Roberts Avenue Replacement School Phase I site clearing and demolition has been completed, and we will visit the State Facility Unit for approval on Phase II in September 2006.
