In the next few months this division will be refurbishing the infields for Rogers Park field number 1,2,3, and 4


The Forestry Division is one of the smallest divisions within the Public Works Department, has worked hard to stay ahead of the paving program, trimming back and dealing with the numerous dead trees within the public right of ways. The division also trimmed trees in the downtown area for better visibility of our traffic signals.

The Highway Division has over the last month milled 1 mile of roadway and paved over 1.6 miles of road. These roads include the intersection of White St. and Locust Ave., Tamarack Ave., Moran Ave., Raquel Dr., Glendale Dr. and Circle Terrace. All of these roads had to have drainage improvements before we could pave. We also installed new drainage and pipe along Grammer School Dr. and new basins and drainage pipes in sections of Driftway Point Road. The Highway Division continues to sweep our city streets and handle sight line problems and sign repair projects. This division is always providing assistance to the other divisions within the Public Works Department.
