

AD HOC REPORT – AFFORDABLE HOUSING INVENTORY

OCTOBER 23, 2006

Chairperson Mary Saracino called the meeting to order at 7:48 p.m. In attendance were committee members Mary Teicholz and Paul Rotello. Also in attendance were Laszlo Pinter, Corporation Counsel, Scott Leroy, Director of Health, Housing and Welfare, Paul Schierloh, Associate Director of the Health Department and Lynn Taborsak, the petitioner. Carolyn Sistrunk, Director of the Housing Authority, could not attend.

Mrs. Saracino stated this committee was appointed to review a request from Mrs. Taborsak to review and monitor affordable inventory in the City of Danbury.

Mrs. Taborsak stated she would like the City to track and monitor the affordable housing it has created through municipal action as well as a yearly inventory.


Discussion took place as to current inventory with deed restrictions in favor of the City and how these inventories are created within the City.

Mrs. Teicholz moved to request from Colleen Burke, Tax Assessor, submit a 30-day report as to the feasibility on card notations for affordable housing and, if feasible, authorize Mrs. Burke to continue with the card notations and to report back to the Common Council with an annual report. Seconded by Mr. Rotello. Motion carried unanimously.

Mrs. Teicholz moved to adjourn at 8:25 p.m. Seconded by Mr. Rotello. Motion carried unanimously.


