TRAINING

All members of the Fire Marshal's Office continue to receive training as required by Connecticut General Statutes. This past month our office assisted in the training and formation of a Fire Brigade at Boehringer Ingelheim.

PUBLIC EDUCATION


Twenty-seven public and parochial schools were provided with detailed fire safety and prevention programs. Fire drill procedures were reviewed and adjusted where necessary. A total of forty-two programs were delivered to more than 10,000 students. All members of the Fire Prevention Bureau participated in annual, ongoing activity.

MISCELLANEOUS ACTIVITIES

Fire Marshal Rickert is now a member of the Danbury School System Emergency Management Task Force. This Task Force was formed to deal with a myriad of safety issues including the possibility of fires or hazardous material releases.

Fire extinguisher training was also provided to City Hall and Library employees.
