
Dear Common Council members:

Please see the attached letter from the Connecticut Department of Public Health as submitted to Health Director Scott Leroy.

With the adoption of Public Act 07-142 passed by the General Assembly and signed into law by Governor Rell on June 25, 2007, it is the law in Connecticut that all parties contracting with the State must adopt a resolution supporting nondiscrimination, as required by Connecticut General Statutes sections 4a-60(a)(1) and 4a-60a(a)(1). Since the city is about to enter into a public health contract with state, the time is right to adopt the attached resolution. Please consider it in the usual fashion.



Dear Mr. Leroy:

Public Act 07-142, passed by the General Assembly and signed into law by Governor Rell on June 25<sup>th</sup> 2007, mandates that all State contractors have a resolution passed by their governing body adopting and supporting nondiscrimination agreements required under Conn. Gen. Stat. § 4a-60(a)(1) and § 4a-60a(a)(1). All contracts signed on or after the effective date of PA 07-142 must include a certification, signed by the contractor's authorized signatory, to verify the resolution has been passed and is in full force and effect.

While the Department of Public Health has an executed contract with the City of Danbury, because it was signed after June 25<sup>th</sup> 2007, we must receive a completed certification of compliance with PA 07-142 to execute the contract.
