The City of Danbury relies on the Public Health Emergency preparedness grant from the State of Connecticut to fund the Department's Emergency Planning and response activities.

This amount has fluctuated over time due to State constraints. The current grant is proposed as a 2-year grant period in the total amount of \$167,422.00. A proposed budget is contained in the application that explains the expenditures related to fulfilling the requirements of the grant.
