RE: 10 Year Plan to End Homelessness

Dear President Cavo:

It has been a year since the Common Council approved the city's 10 year plan to end homelessness. As you know, the plan has a goal of creating 275 units of permanent supportive housing and providing multi-disciplinary support services to the individuals and families who reside in those units. The plan outlines 54 specific recommendations for year one of the plan and it is appropriate for the Council to take stock of the progress that has been made.

You may recall that I was opposed to last year's consolidation of the Department of Health, Housing and Welfare. I am very concerned that the 10 year plan has become lost in the new Mega department and may not be getting the attention it deserves.

As elected city officials, we have an obligation to provide oversight and review of this city sponsored plan. I request the appointment of an Ad Hoc Common Council committee to review and to make recommendations concerning the 10 year plan to end homelessness and any other issues that may arise during these discussions.
