RE: Stricter Traffic Controls - Amend Planning and Zoning Regulations


Dear President Cavo:

We are writing to request the appointment of an Ad Hoc Committee to make recommendations to amend the planning and zoning regulations to impose stricter regulations, parameters and standards of review on any proposed project or application that includes any increase in motor vehicle traffic on any municipal or state road so that the aggregate motor vehicle traffic will be considered.

The need for changes to the current regulations is clear in light of the recent refilling of an application for a Dunkin Donuts on Osborne Street which was previously rejected. The new application no longer requires a public hearing because it will generate only 498 motor vehicle trips, two less than the number needed to trigger a public hearing process.






